## SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, that, on the 12th day of March, 1891, at 2 o'clock p. m., at the County Auditor's office, in the city of Anoka, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 10, of Anoka county, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka county, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 7th, 1891, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement of said ditch, with its branches, at its source, is as follows:

Commencing at a point on the section line between sections 13 and 14, town 31, range 23, about 120 rods north of the quarter post, and thence easterly through sections 13 and 12, said town and range, and section 7, town 31, range 22, to connect with a public ditch known as "Penice Ditch," in said section 7, thence down said ditch about 200 rods, for an outlet and there terminating for a main line. Also a branch to commence at a point on the section line between sections 1 and 12, town 31, range 23, about 80 rods east of the quarter post, and thence in a southerly direction to main ditch in said section 12, for an outlet, and there terminating. Also a branch commencing at or near the west quarter post of section 8, town 31, range 22, and thence in a southeasterly direction to said main ditch in section 7, said town and range, and there terminating; to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent. over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
