The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of *Anoka* County, State  
of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public *Ditch*

along the following described route: *Commencing at or near*  
*a point 80 rods south of the N.E. cor. of Section 24, Town 32*  
*Range 22 in said Anoka County. Thence running in a*  
*generally southerly direction through Sections 24, 25, 36 & 35*  
*said Town and Range, and terminating at Rice Creek*  
*(so called) as its outlet in said Section 35*
