

This memorandum of agreement, made and entered into this 7th day of June, 1905, by and between Louis Harmon, party of the first part, and Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, Minnesota, party of the second part, witnesseth, that first party, for and in consideration of the payments to be made by the party of the second part as hereinafter stated, hereby covenants, promises and agrees, to and with second party, to forthwith commence work upon, and in a first class and workmanlike manner, and to the satisfaction of the second party, on or before July 1st, 1905, complete the opening, cleaning, widening and deepening of ditch No. 19 of said County, from the south line of Greenwald's home farm, to the outlet thereof; ditch to be widened at all points to a minimum of eight feet, and in deep or sand cuts to be as much wider as necessary, slope of sand cuts one to one, ~~four to one~~ and one half, and of others one to one; to deepen the ditch to original grade as established by engineer, and in case said depth in some portions be not deep enough, then deep enough to carry the fall; To line up and straighten ditch on both sides; to throw excavated material back far enough so that the nearest will be at least two feet from the outer edge of the ditch;

This contract to cover also the branch of said ditch; And second party, in consideration of the faithful and full performance of the party of the first part of his part of this agreement, covenants and agrees to pay first party, as and for the full consideration for the fulfillment of this contract, the sum of thirty cents per rod from Greenwald's south line, of home farm, to the center of section twenty one, and thirty five cents per rod from last point to outlet of ditch, for each and every rod so opened, cleaned, widened and deepened, in accordance herewith,

payments to be made of fifty percent of estimated work done,
from time to time, on acceptance by Commissioner Gallagher, and the
balance to be paid in due course of business on acceptance by the
Board of County Commissioners, when the work is completed; work
to be first class in every particular, to be a substantial job, and
to be done to the end that the ditch may be permanently widened,
deepened, opened and improved.

by Commissioner Gallagher, committee in charge of said work.
