Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 13th day of June 1889, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the city of Anoka

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 3 (known as Sparks Ditch) of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date April 15th 1889, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source the place of commencement of said Ditch at its source is as follows, at a point 200 feet north of the south west corner of S.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Section 9 Town 32 Range 25 thence through sections 16, 15, N.E. 1/4, S.E. 1/4 sec 22, sec 14 and 13 terminating in Run River in said Section 13. Town 32 Range 25.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
