AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF PETITION.

(First publication January 24th, 1900.)

Whereas the viewers appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County of Anoka at their session held on the 10th day of July, 1896, upon a petition of E. S. Rogers, Anton Larson, A. O. Johnson and others, bearing date the 9th day of June, 1899, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, have made their report and filed the same in my office. Said ditch to be numbered 57.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their special session to be held at the Court House, in the city of Anoka, in said county, on the 17th day of February, 1900, at 2 o'clock, p. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its center is as follows: Commencing at about the center of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 14; thence in a westerly direction 80 rods; thence south easterly to the south line of Section 14; thence north westerly along the section line to the south 3/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 21; thence in a southerly direction to the south line of Section 21; thence in a south westerly direction to the center of said ditch; thence following the old ditch to Cook Creek.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: A. O. Johnson, Martha Johnson, W. J. Hann, Astor James, A. Hodges, J. B. Hanson, Orma Hansson, John H.
