I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 39 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, 1902

State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date Sept 8th 188, viz.:
In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the ^{ENGINEER'S} ~~engineers~~ in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source from Station No. 179+16

to Station 0 Beginning at Station 179+16 which station is about 600 ft. westerly from the southeast corner of Station No. 19 of T 31 R. 24 and running thence southeasterly in Station No. 13 of T 31 R. 24 and Station No. 18, 19, 20, and 29 of T 31 R. 23 and ending at Station No. 0 near the center 1/2 corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 29 of T 31 R. 23.

and that bids are invited for said work to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said ^{ENGINEER'S} ~~engineer's~~ report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
