In the matter of the petition of Henry Lee and others, for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County, praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning in section 29, in said Town of Blaine, on land belonging to Albert Gottwald, being the sec 1/2 of section 29, running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: Sec 1/2 of nw 1/4, nw 1/4 of nw 1/4, nw 1/4 of nw 1/4, section 29, town 31, range 23, Blaine; e 1/2 of nw 1/4, section 19, town 31, range 23, Blaine; e 1/2 of nw 1/4, section 19, town 31, range 23, Blaine; e 1/2 of nw 1/4, section 18, town 31, range 23, Blaine; ne 1/4 of nw 1/4, section 18, town 31, range 23, Anoka, and terminating at a point in the n 1/2 of ne 1/4 of section 18, town 31, range 24, town of Anoka, and that the names of the owners of the lands that will be affected by the construction of said ditch are as follows, to-wit:
