Whereas, The petition of E. J. Swartz and others, bearing date the 12 on June 1903, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, has been filed in my office,

Now, Therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their special session to be held at the County office in the City of St. Cloud Anoka in said County, on the 10 day of September 1903, at 10 o'clock a. M.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a ditch of ample capacity to drain the land along the following described route in the Town of Blaine and Anoka in said County of Anoka and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility. ditch A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows:
Commencing at a point near the center of Section Thirty three in the Town of Blaine

thence running along the following route: Northwesterly, southerly and westerly through sections twenty eight (28) twenty one (21) sixteen (16) seventeen (17) eight (8) eighteen (18) and seven (7) in the town of Blaine; and through the southeast quarter of Twelve (12) in town of Anoka and emptying into Grand creek at or near the south line of Section Thirteen (13)

and terminating at a point near the line between sections twelve (12) and thirteen in said town of Anoka with said Grand creek

as its outlet also transferred from said ditch as may
be necessary

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such ditch
and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Fifty-eight (258) of
the General Laws of Minnesota for 1901, and subsequent amendments thereto.
