PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Carver
State of Minnesota.

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the Kuster ditch and branch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Kuster ditch and branch along the following described route in the Town of Dele Burn in said County of Carver:

that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and is necessary for the following reasons, ^{to-wit:} that large areas of land along the course of the proposed ditch are now wet, overgrown and rendered useless for any purpose, which by the construction of the proposed ditch, would be rendered productive and useful for farming and other purposes, and large quantities of adjacent water which now collect a nuisance to the public health would be removed by said proposed ditch.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said proposed ditch is as follows:

Commencing at the lowest point in the marsh in the SW 1/4 of the N 2 1/4 of Section 36, Town of ~~Wendell~~ Carver the NW 1/4 of the N 2 1/4 of said section, and across the SW 1/4 of S 2 1/4, East 3, East 4 and NW 1/4 of S 2 1/4 of Section 25, and across the SW 1/4 of S 2 1/4 and the S 2 1/4 of SW 1/4 and NW 1/2 of S 2 1/4 of Section 24, all in Township 23 and Range 24, to Cedar Creek

and terminating in said Cedar Creek

as its outlet;
