The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden JAMES P. ELWELL and C. P. LOVELL

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of ANDOKA County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch, Drain or Water

Course along the following described route Commencing at a point on the Sec. line between sections Thirteen [13] and Fourteen [14] Town Thirty One [31] Range Twenty Three [23] about One Hundred and Twenty [120] rods north of the the quarter post and thence easterly through Sec. Thirteen [13] and Twelve [12] of said Town and range and Sec. Seven [7] Town Thirty One [31] Range Twenty Two [22] to connect with a public ditch known as "Penve Ditch" in said Sec. 7 [Seven] thence down said ditch about [200] rods, two hundred, for an outlet and there terminating for main line. Also a branch to commence at a point on the Sec. line between Sec. One [1] and Twelve [12] Town Thirty One [31] Range Twenty Three [23], about Eighty [80] rods east of the quarter post and thence in a southerly direction to main ditch in said Sec. Twelve [12] for an outlet and there terminating. Also a branch commencing at or near the west quarter post of Sec. Six in Town Thirty One [31] Range Twenty Two [22] and thence in a southerly and easterly direction to said main ditch in Section Seven [7] said town and range for an outlet and there terminating.

Now, if the said JAMES P. ELWELL and C. P. LOVELL
