PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
 State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch Drain or Watercourse with its branches hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a~~ construction of said Ditch Drain or along the following described route in the Town ~~of~~ Watercourse, with its branches, will be conducive to the public health convenience in said County of and welfare and the same ~~to wit: Commencing at~~ will be of public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch Drain or Watercourse along the following described route in the Towns of Blaine and Centerville in said County of Anoka to wit:— Commencing at a point on the section line between sections (13) Thirteen and (14) Fourteen Town (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three about (120) one hundred and twenty rods north of the (14) post and thence easterly through sections (13) Thirteen and (12) Twelve said town and Range and section (7) Seven Town ~~and terminating at~~ (31) thirty one Range (22) to connect with a public Ditch known as "Kinos Ditch" in said section (7) Seven thence down said Ditch about (300) two hundred ~~as its outlet~~ rods for an outlet and thence terminating for main line, Also a branch to commence at a point on the section line between sections (11) and (12) Twelve Town (31) Thirty one Range (23) Twenty three about 50 rods east of the quarter (4) post and thence in a southerly direction to main ditch in said section (12) Twelve for an outlet and thence terminating, Also a branch commencing at or near the west quarter (14) post of section (16) Thirty one Range (22) Town (7) seven said Town and Range for an outlet and thence terminating
