NOTICE OF HEARING

PETITION OF STATE OF MINNESOTA, BY JAMES C. MARSHALL, ITS COMMISSIONER OF HIGHWAYS, FOR THE RIGHT TO MAKE MINOR ALTERATIONS OR CHANGES IN COUNTY DITCH NO. 10, IN ANOKA COUNTY.

TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN COUNTY DITCH NO. 10, IN ANOKA COUNTY:

YOU, AND EACH OF YOU, WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the State of Minnesota, by James C. Marshall, its Commissioner of Highways, has filed a Petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, pursuant to Section 161.28 of Minnesota Statutes 1959, praying that he be allowed to make minor alterations or changes in County Ditch No. 10. That attached to said Petition now on file with the County Auditor are plans and cross-sections marked Exhibit "A" and right of way maps marked Exhibit "C" showing said minor alterations or changes petitioned for. That the portion of said County Ditch No. 10 as now located, which is proposed to be changed or altered, is described as follows:

APPROXIMATE PRESENT LOCATION OF A PORTION OF COUNTY DITCH NO. 10:

Beginning at a point in present County Ditch No. 10 distant 515 feet east and 162 feet north of the west quarter corner of section 17, township 31 north, range 22 west; thence run northwesterly to a point in said County Ditch distant 402 feet east and 192 feet north of said quarter corner; thence run northwesterly to a point in said County Ditch distant 254 feet east and 286 feet north of said quarter corner and there terminating.

APPROXIMATE PROPOSED LOCATION OF A PORTION OF COUNTY DITCH NO. 10:

Beginning at a point in present County Ditch No. 10 distant 515 feet east and 162 feet north of the west quarter corner of section 17, township 31 north, range 22 west; thence run northwesterly to a point distant 479 feet east and 167 feet north of said quarter corner; thence run northwesterly to a point distant 278 feet east and 268 feet north of said quarter corner; thence run northwesterly to a point in present County Ditch No. 10 distant 254 feet east and 286 feet north of said quarter corner and there terminating.

That said Petition alleges that it is advantageous and desirable in the construction and maintenance of Trunk Highway No. 35W that said minor alterations or changes be made, and that said minor alterations or changes petitioned for will not affect the functioning or impair the efficiency of said Anoka County Ditch No. 10.

YOU WILL FURTHER TAKE NOTICE, that said Petition will be presented to the County Board of Anoka County, in the Court House in Anoka, Minnesota, on the 9th day of September, 1963, at 10 o'clock A.M., at which time all persons interested in said ditch system may appear and be heard and present arguments for or against the granting of said Petition.

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the City of Anoka, in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Anoka County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that a copy of each issue has been filed with the State Historical Society.

That the Notice of Hearing hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published in the English language, once each week for three successive weeks; that it was first so published on Friday, the 9th day of

August 1963; and thereafter on Friday of each week

to and including the 23rd day of August 1963; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
