Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in special session at the court house in Anoka, on the 22d day of November, 1890, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing 50 rods west of the north east corner of the $\frac{se}{4}$ of the $\frac{se}{4}$ of section 2, township 32, range 23, thence in a generally southerly and westerly direction through sections 2, 11, 14, 15, 22 and 27 in town 32, range 23.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: J. T. Elwell, Charles Peterson, United States, Geo. B. Hood, W. A. & L. J. Greenwald, Margaret C. Ege and J. H. Ege.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: Terminating in the $\frac{nw}{4}$ of the $\frac{sw}{4}$ of section 27, town 32, range 23, in Coon Creek. Said ditch to be No. 11.
