# PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka  
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch Drain or Watercourse hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a construction of said Ditch Drain along the following described route in the Town of or Watercourse will be considered to the public health in said County of convenience and welfare to-wit: Commencing at and the same will be of public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch Drain or Watercourse along the following described route in the Town of Ham Lake in said County of Anoka commencing at or near the north east corner of South east (14) of the South East quarter (14) of section (2) two Town (32) Thirty two Range (23) Twenty three thence in a generally southerly and westerly direction through sections (11-14-22-23 and 27) eleven fourteen twenty two twenty three and terminating at and 27 said Town and Range to bear creek (so called) as its outlet - and then terminating  
as its outlet

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Ditch Drain or Watercourse and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter 97 General Laws of Minnesota, 1887.
