The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch Drain or Water course hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ require the establishment and construction of a construction of said Ditch Drain along the following described route in the Town of an Watercourse will be conducive to the ~~public health, convenience and welfare~~ and ~~the~~ to-wit: Commencing at same will be of public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commissioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch Drain or Watercourse along the following described route in the Town of Hamus Lake in said County of Anoka commencing at or near the north east corner of Southeast (14) quarter of the South East quarter (14) of section (2) two Town 32, Thirty two Range (23) Twenty three Thence in a generally Southly and Westly direction through sections (11 - 14 - 22 - 23 and 27) eleven, fourteen, Twenty two, Twenty three and Twenty seven said and terminating at Hamus and Range to Ham Creek (so called) as its outlet and thence terminating
