**SALE OF
DITCHING JOBS.**

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th day of March, 1891, at 2 o'clock p. m., at the county auditor's office in the city of Anoka, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the ditch No. 12, of Anoka county, established by the board of county commissioners of Anoka county, state of Minnesota, by their order bearing date January 7th, 1891, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement of said ditch with its branch at its source is as follows: Commencing on the east line of section 30, town 33, range 22, about 40 rods south of the east quarter post of said section, thence easterly in as direct a line as possible through sections 29, 28 and 27 in said town and range, to South Branch creek (so called) thence down said creek to the point where it crosses the county line and there terminating. Also a branch commencing at or near the north quarter post of section 1, town 32, range 23 and thence easterly and northerly through section 6, town 32 range 22 and sections 31 and 32, town 33, range 22 to intersect main line in section 29 said town and range and there terminating, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent. over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
