

Assignment
of
Money, Demands and Claims
Due from Dakota County to
Andrew Peterson. to
Christian Loken

Know all men by these presents that I,
Richard Peterson of the Town of Crows, in the County of Anoka
and State of Minnesota, party of the first part, in consideration
of the sum of (\$250.00) Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars to me in
hand paid by Christian Loken, of the Town of Horn Lake, in the
County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, party of the second part,
the receipt whereof, I do herby acknowledge, — do hereby
w^eign, transfer, sell, and set over to the Christian Loken
the said party of the second part, — all the claims and demands, which
I now have against the said County of Anoka, for the construction of certain
Ditch, designated as Ditch No. (12) twelve, which said number has been
given to said Ditch by G. W. Putnam, the County Auditor of said Anoka
County, — Which said Ditch I have dug and fully constructed and
finished in complete fulfillment and execution of certain contract
and bond, entered into and given for the construction and digging of said
Ditch, — Which said contract and bond for the construction of said
Ditch was made and entered into on the Twenty Sixth Day of March
A. D. 1891 by and between myself as party of the first part, and G. W. Putnam
County Auditor of said Anoka County, as party of the second part, and which
said bond was duly executed on the Seventh Day of April A. D. 1891, and
which said Contract and Bond are now on file and record in the
Offices of the County Auditor of said Anoka County.

And I do hereby assign, transfer, sell, and set over
unto him the said Christian Loken, the said party of the second part, for the
consideration above mentioned, all of the said claims and demands,
which I now have, and all which, at any time between the date hereof
and the date when the said Ditch, or now finished and dug, shall
have been fully and completely accepted by the County
Surveyor of said County of Anoka, — I may and shall
have against the said County of Anoka, for all sums of
money now due and a^{cts} yet undispaid and that may become
due for the full and complete construction of said Ditch.

To have and to hold the same to him the
said Christian Loken, the will and his executors,

money now due and as yet undispaid and that may become
due for the full and complete construction of said Dilett.

To have and to hold the same to him the
said Christian Loken, the said party of the second part, his
executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I, the
said Andrew Peterson, the said party of the second part, do hereby
constitute and appoint the said Christian Loken, the said party
of the second part, and his assigns, to be my true and lawful
Attorney irrevocable in the premises, to do and perform all
acts, matters and things touching the premises in the like manner to
administer and purvey as I might myself do if personally
present.
