Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch designated as No. 12 which number has been given to said Ditch by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1891, and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;


