## Order Appointing Viewers.

The place of commencement of said ditch and its branch at its source is as follows: Main ditch commencing 570 feet east and 142 feet south of the west quarter post of section 29, town 33, range 22, thence generally easterly and northerly through sections 29, 28, 27, 22, 20, 23 and 24 in town 33, range 22. Also a branch commencing 170 feet south 76° east of the north quarter post of section 1, town 32, range 23, thence generally northerly and easterly through section 1, town 32, range 23, and section 6, town 32, range 22, and sections 31, 32 and 29 in town 33, range 22.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch and its branch passes are as follows: James T. Elwell, John Heil, G. Kappler, Yost Yost, J. H. Batzle, Joseph Sauson, C. Lendt, H. Gotzow.

The place of termination of said ditch and its branch at its outlet is as follows: Main ditch in South Branch Creek, "so called," where said creek crosses the county line 410 feet north of the east quarter post of section 24, town 33, range 22. branch ditch terminating in the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of section 29, town 33, range 22, at stake 32 of main ditch. Said ditch to be No. 12.

Whereas, A petition bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May  
1890., signed by Gas. J. Ellwell

praying for the establishment of a certain Ditch Drain or Water course <sup>with its Branch</sup> in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And Whereas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Aitka County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

And Whereas, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit or utility, or conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare;

Now, Therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a regular session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint S. M. Hatch  
John Dawson and John Hunter  
three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1890., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Aitka at 10 o'clock A.M. as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1890.
