Know all Men by These Presents,

That James T. Ellwell and C. P. Lowell

are held and firmly bound unto the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in the sum of Two hundred (\$200) DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 31st day of May one thousand eight hundred and ninety.

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden James T. Ellwell and C. P. Lowell

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch Drain or Water Course along the following described route: Commencing on the east line of Section Thirty [30] Town Thirty Three [33] Range Twenty Two [22] about Forty [40] Rods south of the East quarter post of said Section, thence easterly in a direct line as possible through Sections Twenty Nine [29], Twenty Eight [28] and Twenty Seven [27] in said Town and Range to South Branch Creek [so-called] thence down said creek to the point where it crosses the County line and there terminating. Also a branch commencing at or near the north quarter post of Sec. One [1] Town Thirty Two [32] Range Twenty Three [23] and thence easterly and northerly through Section Six [6] Town Thirty Two [32] Range Twenty Two [22] and Sections Thirty One [31] and Thirty Two [32] Town Thirty Three [33] Range Twenty Two [22] to intersect main line in Section Twenty Nine [29] said Town and Range and there terminating.

Now, if the said James T. Ellwell and C. P. Lowell

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County shall fail to establish said proposed Ditch Drain or Water Course then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
