## SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, that on the 1st day of August, 1891, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office, in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka, I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 13 of Anoka county, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka county, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date June 6th, 1891, viz: In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence successively, up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement of said ditch is as follows: Commencing at or near the northeast corner of of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 3, town 33, range 23, thence through sections 3, 2, 10, 15, 21, 20, 23, 29 and 30 all in town 33, range 23, to where the State Road crosses Crooked Brook (so called) in said section 30, and there terminating for a Main line. Branch line commencing at or near the section corner common to sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 in town 33, range 23, thence through sections 8, 9, 16, 21 and 20 in said town and range into Crooked Brook (so called), thence down said brook to join the Main line in the S. 1/4 of said section 20, to the lowest responsible bidder of bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
