Of John Mitchell John K. Dawson and Others

Whereas, A petition bearing date the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October  
 1880, signed by John Mitchell John K. Dawson Mrs. Lizzie Pracie G. M. Hughes N. Mertz  
Thomas Turner R. W. Dawson John Thumby John E. Purman A. D. Purman S. S. Fryer  
J. T. Dorsey Edson S. Dawson John A. Storker J. J. S. Blwell M. E. Dawson Howard R. Ridge  
Joseph Walvoda Jas. V. Broadbent Reuben Ridge John N. Howe Frederick Schum  
 praying for the establishment of a certain Ditch with its Branch in said County, the  
 route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same,  
 have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And Whereas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of  
Anoka County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency  
 of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as  
 required by law;

And Whereas, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed  
 in said petition will be of public benefit or utility, or conducive to the public health, convenience or  
 welfare;

Now, Therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a regular  
 session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint L. M. Hatch  
John Hunter and A. A. Barnes  
 three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed  
 work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 26<sup>th</sup>  
 day of February 1881, at the County Auditor's Office in the City  
of Anoka at 10 o'clock A.M. as the time and place for said viewers to meet,  
 preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing  
 their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County,  
 on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1881.
