have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
 of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch and
its Branches along the following described route: in the Town of Bethel in
said County of Anoka commencing at or near the North East
corner of the North west quarter of the South West quarter (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
of section three (3) Town Thirty three (33) Range Twenty three (23) Thence
in a Southernly and westerly direction through Section three (3) said
Town & Range to Grass Lake, so called, Thence Southernly and
Westerly to the outlet of said Grass Lake through sections three (3)
and ten (10) said Town and Range and down said outlet
of Grass Lake to Deer Lake so called, in section fifteen (15)
said Town and Range, Thence Southernly and westerly through

~~Now, if the said~~ said Deer Lake through Section fifteen (15) said
Town & Range to the South side of said Lake Thence Southernly
and westerly through sections twenty one (21) and twenty (20)
to Crooked Brook so called where said Brook crosses the
North line of the South East Quarter of the South East
quarter (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) of said section twenty (20) and thence
down said Crooked Brook through sections twenty (20)
Twenty nine (29) & thirty (30) to where the State Road crosses said
Crooked Brook and there terminating for the Main Line.

Also a branch line commencing at or near the section
 corner common to section four (4) five (5) eight (8) and
 nine (9) Town Thirty three (33) Range Twenty three (23)

And westerly through sections twenty one (21) and twenty (20) to Crooked Brook so called where said Brook crosses the North line of the South East Quarter of the South East quarter (S.E. 1/4) of said section twenty (20) and thence down said Crooked Brook through sections twenty (20) twenty nine (29) & thirty (30) to where the state Road crosses said Crooked Brook and there terminating for the main line.

Also a branch line commencing at or near the section corner common to section four (4) five (5) eight (8) and nine (9) Town thirty three (33) Range Twenty three; Thence southerly and easterly through said sections eight (8) and nine (9) into Redd Lake so called across said Redd Lake to Mud Lake so called in section sixteen (16) said town and range and thence through said Mud Lake and across sections sixteen (16) twenty one (21) and twenty (20) said town and Range into Crooked Brook and thence down said Brook to join the main line in the South East quarter of said section twenty (20)
