Notice is Hereby Given, That a petition for a public ditch, of which the following is a copy, has been filed with the County Auditor, and will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, at their next session, on the 21st day of February 1887, or as soon thereafter as the same can be heard:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch with its Branch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the ~~public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of~~ said Ditch and its Branch will ~~along the following described route in the Town of~~ be conducive to the public health convenience and welfare in said County of and the same will be of ~~to wit: Commencing at~~ public benefit and utility and we the undersigned hereby petition and request the said Board of County Commis- sioners to cause to be constructed a Ditch along the following described Route in the town of Bethel in said County of Anoka to wit: Commencing at or near the north East corner of the North west quarter of the South west quarter (NW 1/4, SW 1/4) of Section three (3) Town Thirty three (33) Range Twenty three (23) Thence in a southerly and westerly direction through Section three (3) said town and Range to Grass Lake, so called Thence southerly and westerly to the outlet of said Grass Lake through sections ~~and terminating at~~ three (3) & ten (10) said town and Range and down said outlet of Grass Lake to Deer Lake so called in section fif- teen (15) said town and Range Thence southerly and westerly as its outlet through said Deer Lake through Section fifteen (15) said Town & Range to the South side of said Lake Thence southerly and westerly through sections twenty one (21) and twenty (20) to

Through sections twenty (20), twenty nine (29) & thirty (30) to where the State
Road crosses said Crooked Brook and there terminating for the main line

1 Also a branch line commencing at or near the Section
2 corner common to sections four (4) five (5) eight (8) and
3 nine (9) Town Thirty three (33) Range Twenty three; Thence
4 southerly and easterly through said sections eight (8) and
5 nine (9) ~~seven (7)~~ into Muds Lake so called, across
6 said Muds Lake to Mud Lake, so called in Section Sixteen
7 (16) said town and range and thence through said
8 Mud Lake and across sections sixteen (16) twenty one
