## Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, } ss.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Bethel, of said Anoka county, upon the petition of John Mitchell, John K. Dawson, Mrs. Lizzie Gracie, C. W. Hughes, H. Mertz, Thomas Turner, R. W. Dawson, John T. Grandy, John E. Purmort, A. D. Purmort, S. S. Dyer, J. T. Dougherty, Edsen S. Dawson, John A. Starkey, Freeman Cochran, Jas. T. Elwell, Howard R. Ridge, Joseph Valvoda, Jas. T. Broadbent, Reuben Ridge, M. E. Dawson and John H. Howe, bearing date the 15th day of October, 1890, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch and branch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their special session at the court house, in Anoka, on the 6th day of June, 1891, at 11 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch and branch, at its source, is as follows: Main line commencing at or near the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter, of section three, town 33, range 23, thence in a southerly and easterly direction through section 3, to Grass Lake, so called, thence southerly and westerly to the outlet of said Grass Lake, through sections 3 and 10, and down said outlet of Grass Lake to Deer Lake, so called, in section 15, thence southerly and westerly through said Deer Lake, through section 15, to the south side of said lake, thence southerly and westerly through sections 21 and 20 to Crooked Brook, so called, where said Brook crosses the north line of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said section 20, and thence down said Crooked Brook through sections 20, 29 and 30.

Branch line commencing at or near the section corner common to sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, town 33, range 23, thence southerly and easterly through said sections 8 and 9 into Ned's Lake, so called, across said Ned's Lake to Mud Lake, so called, in section 16, thence through said Mud Lake and across sections 16, 21 and 20, into Crooked Brook, and thence down said Brook to join the main line.
