The place of commencement of said ditch at its source, is as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, of section 28, town 33, range 25, thence in a generally easterly and southerly direction through said section 28 and sections 27 and 34 of said town and range, and sections 3 and 2 in town 32, range 25.
