They are to accept road labor, if offered, from the persons on the list, in payment of the sums assessed, to be worked out when and where in the District the Overseer may direct, at the rate of \$1.50 per day for an able-bodied man, and the same amount for the of \$1.50 per day for an able-bodied man, and the same amount for the use of a team and wagon or plow.

When such sum is paid, either in money or road labor, the Overseer must write PAID against such name or tract of land in the list. On or before October 1st, he must fill out and sign the following certificate, and deliver the list to the Town Clerk, who must receive and keep the same on file.

On or before the third Saturday of October for the purpose of revising the list of delinquent road taxes for the current year, the several Overseers of Highways and the Town Clerk must cancel or strike from said list all personal property taxes which, in their opinion, can not be collected.—G. L. 1899, ch. 219.

The Town Clerk must then, on or before November 1st, make out and deliver to the County Auditor a list containing a description of each tract or parcel of land on which the tax is delinquent, with the name of the owner, if known, and if unknown to so state, and the amount of tax due and remaining unpaid on each, and containing all of the unpaid road taxes levied upon personal property according to the lists on file in his office, and shall make his certificate thereon to the effect that the same is a correct list of delinquent road taxes for that year, as appears from the several lists returned by the Overseers of Highways and on file in his office.
