for a Repairs County Ditch in the County of Anoka

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka

State of Minnesota:

The undersigned Civil Engineer, appointed by your order bearing date the 21st day of September 1920, to view the route proposed in the petition of Erik Sanderson

for a public Repairs County Ditch No. 14

would respectfully report that at the time specified in your said order, he made an accurate survey of the line of said proposed Repairs County Ditch from its source to its outlet, and caused stakes to be set along said line, numbered progressively down stream at each 100 feet, and caused a plat of said survey of said proposed ditch to be made, showing among other things a complete description of the lands over which said ditch is surveyed, which plat is made a part of this report and attached hereto, marked Exhibit No. 1

And did make a computation of the number of cubic yards of earth to be excavated and removed from said ditch and Branches between each of the 100 foot stakes, and the estimated cost per cubic yard for the removal thereof, and did sum up the total number of cubic yards to be excavated and removed from the entire length of said ditch and Branches and an estimate of the total cost of laying out, establishing and construction of the whole work. And did cause the same to be prepared in tabular form, also giving the depth of cut, width at the bottom and width at the top, at the source, outlet and each one hundred foot stake of said Ditch and Branches which tabulated statement is made a part of this report and hereto attached, marked Exhibit No. 2

And did, as by law required, specify the time and manner in which said work shall be done, and (in case of underground work) did specify the size and kind of tile to be used, or other material necessary in such underground work, and did estimate the cost of the same as a part of the total cost of said work, which statement and specifications and estimates are made a part of this report and hereto attached, marked No. 2

And did cause to be made a statement of the names of the laborers, and the time each was employed by him, and every other item of expense by him incurred in and about said work, which statement is
