Notice is Hereby Given, That a petition, of which the following is a copy, will be presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka in the State of Minnesota, at a Special session thereof, commencing on the ~~13th~~ 10th day of May A. D. 1899, or as soon thereafter as the same can be heard.

PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota;

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch or Ditches hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a Public Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Burns in said county of Anoka and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said Public Ditch is as follows.

Commencing at or near the North West corner of Sec Seventeen (17) ^{Range 33} ^{Range (24)} thence in a South Easterly course to Bear Lake leaving Bear Lake at the South East corner thence in a North Easterly course through Sec sixteen (16) to Goose Lake leaving Goose Lake at the North East corner and following a North East course to Pineville Lake leaving Pineville Lake by what is known as Ford Brook and following the same to its junction with Trout Brook or so far as is necessary to make an open waterway to Rain River together with such Branch Ditch or Ditches as the Viewers may deem necessary

and terminating at

as its outlet

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such Public Ditch
and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Ninety-Seven (97) of the General Laws
of Minnesota for 1887, and subsequent amendments thereto.
