SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 12th day of March 1892, at 10 o'clock A. M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Anoka and County of Anoka

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 14 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date November 21st 1891, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source.

The place of commencement of said Ditch is as follows commencing at the Southwest corner of the N. W. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of Section 28 Town 33, Range 25 Thence in a generally Eastern and Southern direction through said Section 28 and Sections 27 and 34 of said Town and Range and Sections 3 and 2 in Town 32, Range 25 and terminating in Maris Brook (so called) in the North west quarter of said Section 2.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
