PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construction of the Ditch or Ditches hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of A Public Ditch along the following described route in the Town of Burns in said County of Anoka and that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows

Commencing at or near the North West Corner
of Sec 17 Range 21 thence in a South
Easterly course to Bear Lake leaving Bear
Lake near the South East corner thence
East in a North Easterly course through Sec
(16) Sixteen to Goose Lake leaving Goose
Lake at the North East corner and following
a North East course to Pinacle Lake
leaving Pinacle Lake by what is known
as Ford Brook and following the same
to its junction with Gratt Brook or so
far as is necessary to make an open water
way to Rum River

Including such Branch Ditch or Ditches as
the Viewers may deem necessary
