To the Honorable, The Board of County Commissioners of
the County of Anoka, Minnesota.

The undersigned residents and
free holders of said County do hereby respectfully remon-
strate against the granting of a certain petition now be-
fore your Honorable Body, signed by Eugene Herrick and
others, asking that a County Ditch be laid out and estab-
lished as provided by law, to begin in section eighteen (18)
in township thirty three (33), range twenty five (25) in
said County and to run in direction therein named and to
connect with Ford Brook.

The grounds of the
public needs do not require such ditch-that it will not
conducive to the public health, welfare or convenience to an
extent warranting its being established and constructed and
further your remonstrants allege that they will be damaged
in their lands, which would be affected by such ditch, to an
amount and in a sum of money exceeding any benefefits that
could rightly and properly be derved therefrom .
