**Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.**

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Columbus, of said Anoka county, upon the petition of Henry De Reieux, Augustus Ropp, Theodore Briant, Pierre Crete, John B. Houle and C. Cardinal, bearing date the 16th day of July, 1891, and on file in my office, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in regular session, at the court house, in the city of Anoka, on the 5th day of January, 1892, at 10 o'clock, a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch at its source, is as follows: Commencing at or near a point 80 rods south of the northeast corner of section 24, town 32, range 22, thence in a generally southerly and westerly direction through sections 24, 25, 36 and 35, in said town and range.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes, are as follows: John B. Houle, Pierre Crete, C. Cardinal, A. Bergeron, W. D. Lord, L. W. R. Terry, Theodore Briant, Augustus Ropp.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet, is as follows: In Rice Creek, (so called) in section 35, town 32, range 22, and to be known as ditch No. 15.

The names of the owners of the lands that will be affected thereby are John Houle, Peter Crete, C. Cardinal, Alfred Bergeron, W. D. Lord, Sylvon Nadeau, L. W. R. Terry, Theodore Briant, Augustus Ropp.
