petitioners to cause to be constructed a ditch along the following

described Route in the town of Columbus

in said County of Anoka to-wit:

Commencing at or near a point 80 rods south of the N.E. cor

of Section 24, Town 32, Range 22, in said Anoka County, Thence

Running in a generally southerly direction through Sections 24 - 25

- 26 & 35, said Town & Range, and terminating at Rice Creek

(so called) as its outlet in said Section 35,

and terminating at

as its outlet.
