Auditor's Notice of Pending of Petition.

STATE OF MINNESOTA, COUNTY OF ANOKA—ss.

Whereas, the owners of certain lands in the town of Bethel, of said Anoka county, upon the petition of A. D. Purmort, John T. Grundy, Thomas Tanner, R. W. Dawson, Ernoh Russell, John E. Purmort, L. Russell, Jos. Valvoda, Ole Ericson, August Swanson, Hiram Baker, J. T. Broadbent and Clarence Baker, bearing date the 4th day of January, 1892, and on the 11th day of July, 1892, praying for the establishment of a public ditch, drain or water course along the route proposed therein.

Now, therefore, notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and determined before the said Board of County Commissioners, at their meeting in regular session at the court house, in the city of Anoka, commencing on the 11th day of July, 1892, at 10 o'clock a. m.

The place of commencement of said ditch, at its source, is as follows: Commencing at or near the centre of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 11, town 33, north of range 23, west, thence in a southeasterly direction through said section 11 and sections 12 and 13, said town and range.

The names of the persons through whose lands the proposed ditch passes are as follows: James T. E. Iwell.

The place of termination of said ditch at its outlet is as follows: In Rice Lake (so called), in said section 13. Ditch to be known as ditch No. 16.

The names of the owners of the lands that will be affected thereby are James T. E. Iwell, J. T. Grundy, Jasper N. Cole, Rose Baker and town of Bethel for a road.
