A continuation report on County Ditch No. 16 was presented and read.

It was moved by Commissioner Broadbent and seconded by Commissioner Ward that the report be accepted and that R. G. Streeley, Engineer be authorized to proceed with the work. Motion carried.

Continuation of Report on County Ditch No. 16

On August 28, 1948, a representative of the DuPont Powder Co. and myself made a further investigation of the feasibility of using dynamite to open the last 1300 feet of the above numbered ditch. It was his opinion that the project could be accomplished satisfactorily with dynamite and gave me the following figures:

1000 lbs. of ditching dynamite	\$260.00
3 days for expert powder man @ \$35.00	105.00
2 men 3 days labor @ \$8.00	<u>48.00</u>
Total	\$413.00

It was estimated by Mr. H. T. Hanson, expert powder man, that the project could be completed in two days provided satisfactory help can be obtained and no unforeseen difficulties arise.
