The County Auditor presented to the Board a petition for the repair of Ditch No. 16 in the Township of Bethel.

After considering the foregoing application having heard all who wished to be heard the Board decided that a hearing on said petition before the appointment of an engineer would be unnecessary.

Thereupon Commissioner Ward offered the following resolution, said resolution being seconded by Commissioner Ramsden:

RESOLVED that this Board having determined that certain minor repairs are necessary on said Ditch No. 16, we hereby appoint and designate Harold E. Blewett as Engineer to make a careful investigation and survey as to the work necessary to restore the ditch to its original condition. That after such survey and investigation has been made the said Engineer make a complete written report to the Board at its next meeting to be held on November 12, 1945. This report should show the amount of material required and the probable cost of same and the amount of labor required and the probable cost of same.

IT WAS FURTHER RESOLVED that Engineer Blewett be and is hereby authorized to employ an assistant engineer if he find such assistance necessary.

Upon roll call vote, all voted "yes" and the resolution was declared adopted.
