M., at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Aurika and County of Aurika I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 16 of Aurika County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Aurika County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date July 11th 1892, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source the place of commencement of said ditch is as follows —
Commencing at the S 1/4 of the S 34 of T 114 of Sec 11
Town 33. Range 23 Well there is a generally
South easterly course through said section 11,
and through the S 1/4 of S 1/4 of section 12, and
through section 13, well in said town and range
to said terminating in Rice Lake (so called) in
said section 13 as its outlet.

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract.
