# In the Matter of the Petition

Of A. D. Parnwell and Others

for a State Drainage Watercourse in the County of Shuaska

Whereas, A petition bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of January 1882, signed by A. D. Parnwell, John G. Knudby, James Hansen & M. Johnson, Emiel Ruessell, John E. Parnwell & Russell Geo. Valbrunn, O. G. Garrison, August Swanson, Nilsen Baker & P. G. Broadbent Allen Blaine Boyer praying for the establishment of a certain State Drainage Watercourse in said County, the route of which is more fully described in said petition, and a proper bond accompanying the same, have been filed with the County Auditor of said County, as by law required;

And whereas, It appears, by satisfactory proof to the Board of County Commissioners of Shuaska County, that at least thirty (30) days' notice of the pendency of said petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given as required by law;

And whereas, Said Board has determined that the construction of such ditch as proposed in said petition will be of public benefit or utility, or conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare;

Now, therefore, We, the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a <sup>Special</sup> ~~regular~~ session held this day, do hereby accept said petition, do hereby appoint A. M. Hataek Frank McIntirey & Olin Brown

three resident freeholders of said County, and not interested in the construction of said proposed work, and not of kin to any parties interested therein, as viewers, and do specify the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1882, at Madock at the County Auditor's Office in the City of Shuaska as the time and place for said viewers to meet, preparatory to commencing their duties as such viewers, as prescribed by law, and after completing their duties as such viewers to make and file their report with the County Auditor of said County, on or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May 1882
