

SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is hereby given, that on the 10th day of September, 1892, at 10 o'clock a. m. at the County Auditor's Office, in the city of Anoka and construction of the Ditch No. 16 of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date July 11, 1892, viz.: In sections of 100 feet each, each said section to be known and numbered by stakes as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and front thence successively up stream to the one including the source. The place of commencement of said Ditch is as follows: Commencing in the S¹/₂ of the sec¹ of Sec. 11, Town 33, Range 23 west, thence in a generally southerly course through said section 11, and through the S¹/₂ of S¹/₂ of section 12, and through section 13, all in said Town and Range, and terminating in Rice Lake (so called) in said section 13, as its outlet, to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner prescribed, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with the required securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
