 The place of commencement of said ditch at its source is as follows: Commencing at or near the north line of the nw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ of section 29, town 31, range 23, thence southwesterly through the w¹/₂ of sw¹/₄ of said section 29, through the w¹/₂ of nw¹/₄ of section 32, through the ne¹/₄ of section 31, and e¹/₂ of nw¹/₄ of section 31, and the sw¹/₄ of section 31, all in town 31, range 23, thence through the se¹/₄ of section 33, town 31, range 24, thence southerly through the e¹/₂ of section 3, town 30, range 24 and sw¹/₄ of said section 3, and terminating in a creek near Michael Casey's house in said section 3, town 30, range 24, as its outlet; this being Ditch No. 17, Anoka county.
