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This Contract, Made this 15th day of March 1893, by and between Peter Lundberg of Anoka Co. party of the first part, and G. W. Putnam County Auditor of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in behalf of Anoka County, Minnesota, WITNESSETH:

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch designated as No. 17 which number has been given to said Ditch by the County Auditor.

by their order, bearing date the 3rd day of Jan. 1893, and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

And Whereas, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, commencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source, held March 9, 1893, the said G. W. Putnam County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said Peter Lundberg he being the lowest and best responsible bidder, the job of digging and constructing the following sections thereof, numbered as follows from said outlet, to-wit: From sta. 0 to 53 inc., 68, 69, + 80 to 84 inc. + 100 including a bridge at the respective prices amounting in the aggregate to seventy nine + 43/100 dollars (\$79.43)

Now, in Consideration of the Said Premises, The said Peter Lundberg hereby contracts and agrees to construct such share or allotment in the time and manner set forth in said order and the report of said viewers on which said Ditch was established, and so on file as aforesaid,

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas, at a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing a certain Ditch designated as No. 17 held mch 9, 1893 certain sections thereof numbered 1 to 5 inc, 6, 7, 69, 80 to 84 inc + 100 were duly sold to the said Peter Lundberg and said Peter Lundberg has made a contract with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, bearing date 15th day of March 1893, to construct the same;

Now, If the said Peter Lundberg shall and will faithfully perform and fulfill his said contract, and pay all damages which may accrue by reason of the failure to complete the said job within the time and in the manner required in the said contract therefor, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
