To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners
Of Anoka County.

Gentlemen:-

Complying with instructions of the County Attorney I have the honor to report that I have surveyed part of the S 1/2 of the NE. 1/4 of Section No. 36 T. 31 R. 24 Township of Anoka with reference to the part of that tract of land which will naturally drain into the County Ditch laying just south of the said tract. I forward herewith a plat of the same and the elevations obtained by running levels over the said land.

I find that most of the east half of the tract will drain naturally into the said ditch, part of which is high land and is either covered with tame hay or Oak trees and underbrush. I should estimate that Twenty-Four acres is low ground and is now or can be drained into the ditch.
