I ask for this correction and allowance by your Honorable Board for the reason that I have received no benefit & neither will I receive any benefit in any manner whatever by reason of the work done at said time and for which said tax was laid.

I might call the Boards attention to the fact that the tax was levied and the work done without any notice to me in any manner whatever; that the law makes no provision for the award of damages by reason of the taking of property in widening and deepening the ditch; in fact I have many reasons for this request but at this time I base it on the ground that no benefits accrued to me in any manner.

Should this request be denied, I expressly reserve the right to attack said tax on any and all grounds I may have and this request is not to be construed as in any manner a waiver of any of my rights in the premises.
