SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.
 Notice is hereby given, that, on the 6th day of
 May, 1893, at 2 o'clock p. m., at the County Audi-
 tor's Office in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka,
 and State of Minnesota, I will sell the jobs of
 digging and constructing the Ditch No. 19 of
 Anoka County, established by the Board of
 County Commissioners of Anoka County, State
 of Minnesota, by their order bearing date March
 11th, 1893, viz.: In sections of 100 feet each, each
 of said sections to be known and numbered by
 stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in
 said matter, commencing at the one including the
 outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream
 to the one including the source; the place of com-
 mencement of said Ditch main line is as follows:
 In the nw¹/₄ ne¹/₄ of Sec. 25, Town 33, Range 24;
 th. west into ne¹/₄ nw¹/₄ of said Sec. 26; th. south-
 erly, northwesterly and southerly into ne¹/₄ nw¹/₄
 of Sec. 20, T. 33, R. 24 and terminating in Rum
 River as its outlet in said ne¹/₄ nw¹/₄ of said Sec.
 20. Also Branch No. 1 commencing in sw¹/₄ se¹/₄
 of Sec. 27, T. 34, R. 24; th. southerly to connect
 with Main Ditch in Sec. 2, T. 33, R. 24, as its out-
 let. Also Branch No. 2, commencing in nw¹/₄ of
 Sec. 27, Town 33, Range 24; th. northerly to cor-
 ner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 & 28, said Town
 and Range; th. westerly thro' n¹/₄ ne¹/₄ Sec. 25,
 to connect with Main Ditch in said ne¹/₄ ne¹/₄ of Sec.
 25, T. 33, R. 24, at its outlet, to the lowest respon-
 sible bidder or bidders, said work to be comple-
 ted within the time required, and in the manner
 specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid
 will be entertained which exceeds more than
 thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated
 cost of the construction, in any case, as stated
 in the said order; and the successful bidder will
 be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two
 freehold securities, for the faithful performance
 and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all
 damages that may accrue by reason of his failure
 to complete the job within the time required in
 the contract. The said order and estimates and
