201st Ave	Ditch well defined and flowing.
CR # 67	Ditch well defined and flowing. Branch ditch connection to Lake
	George about 1/4 mole downstream.
221st Ave	Ditch well maintained, no apparent flow. Active peatland farming
	to north and south.
CR # 103	At west crossing the ditch is not noticeable. Overgrown marsh.
	Peatland farming to north and south.
CR # 103	At east crossing the ditch is well maintained. No apparent flow.
CSAH # 24	At east crossing the ditch is overgrown with grass. No apparent
	flow. Peatland farming to south.
CSAH # 24	At west crossing the ditch is defined on the south side. Marsh land
	on both sides of road.

ACTIVITIES:
