SALE OF DITCHING JOBS.

Notice is Hereby Given, That, on the 6th day of May 1893, at 2 o'clock P. M., at the County Auditor's Office of the County of Anoka County of Anoka and State of Minnesota

I will sell the jobs of digging and constructing the Ditch No. 19th of Anoka County, established by the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, by their order bearing date March 11th 1893, viz.:

In sections of 100 feet each, each of said sections to be known and numbered by stakes, as shown by the report of the viewers in said matter, commencing at the one including the outlet, and from thence, successively, up stream to the one including the source, the place of commencement of said Ditch Main line is as follows: in the N.W. 1/4 N.E. 1/4 of sec. 26 T. 34 R. 24; thence West into N.E. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of said sec. 26; thence southerly, northwesterly and southerly thro' N.E. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of sec. 20 T. 33 R. 24 and terminating in River Bluff as its outlet in said N.E. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 of said sec. 20; also Branch No. 1 com. in S.W. 1/4 S.E. 1/4 of sec. 27 T. 34 R. 24; thence southerly to connect with Main Ditch in sec. 2 T. 33 R. 24 as its outlet; also Branch No. 2 com. in N.W. 1/4 of sec. 27 T. 33 R. 24; thence northerly to corner common to sections 21, 22, 27 & 28 said T. 33 R. 24; thence westerly thro' N.W. 1/4 N.E. 1/4 sec. 28 to connect with Main Ditch in said N.W. 1/4 N.E. 1/4 of sec. 28 T. 33 R. 24 as its outlet

to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders, said work to be completed within the time required, and in the manner specified, in said viewer's report. And no bid will be entertained which exceeds more than thirty (30) per cent over and above the estimated cost of the construction, in any case, as stated in the said order; and the successful bidder will be required to give a satisfactory bond, with two freehold securities, for the faithful performance and fulfillment of his contract, and to pay all damages that may accrue by reason of his failure to complete the job within the time required in the contract. The said order and estimates and profile are on file, and may be seen at my office.
