This Contract, Made this 8th day of June 1887, by and between M. Tobin of Hennepin County party of the first part, and G. W. Putnam County Auditor of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in behalf of Anoka County, Minnesota, WITNESSETH:

Whereas, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, did establish and order to be constructed a certain Ditch designated as No. 2 which number has been given to said Ditch by the County Auditor

by their order, bearing date the 4th day of March 1887, and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

And Whereas, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, commencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source, held May 2^d 1887, the said G. W. Putnam County Auditor as aforesaid, did duly sell to the said M. Tobin he being the lowest and best responsible bidder, the job of digging and constructing the following sections thereof, numbered as follows from said outlet, to-wit: 88 to 79 both inclusive 77, 75, 74, 73, 72, 69 to 57 both inclusive and 2 for the respective prices amounting in the aggregate to Two Hundred Ten & 51/100 Dollars

Now, in Consideration of the Said Premises, The said M. Tobin hereby contracts and agrees to construct such share or allotment in the time and manner set forth in said order and the report of said viewers on which said Ditch was established, and so on file as aforesaid,

Tobin* shall and will faithfully perform and fulfill his said contract, and pay all damages which may accrue by reason of the failure to complete the said job within the time and in the manner required in the said contract therefor, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
