designated as No. 2 which number has been given to said Ditch & Branch

by their order, bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of March 1889,  
and according to the report of the viewers thereof, all of which  
are on file in the office of the said County Auditor;

And Contractors, At a public sale of the jobs of digging and constructing the entire work in  
linear sections of 100 feet each, each of which sections is marked and known and numbered by the  
stake set by said viewers at the foot of each of said sections, as shown by the viewers' report, com-  
mencing at the one including the outlet, and thence, in succession, to the one including the source,  
held May 2<sup>d</sup> 1889, the said Frank Soben
