

To the Board of County Commissioners
County of Ancker and State of Minnesota

The undersigned freeholders would petition
your Board to cause to be laid out and
constructed a ditch drain or watercourse
as provided for in Chapter (27) ninety seven
of the General Laws of Minnesota for the year
1887. which will be of great public utility and
benefit, and will greatly, we believe, promote
the health of the community through which it may
pass. The proposed ditch is described as follows;

to wit: Commencing about 25 rods South
of the Northwest corner of the South West quarter
of Section No. 8 Twp. 32 N. of Range 23 W.

thence Northwestly through the South West
and Northwest quarters of said Section 8.

thence Westly and Southwesterly across the
South East corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 9 and

Southwesterly across
the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the same, and again running
South Easterly across the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, to a point
where the course of the stream crosses the Coon
Lake & Shepard road, near the line between sec-
tions 8 and the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17. thence

a little west of South for about 105 rods;
thence Southwesterly to the original watercourse

and continuing in a Southwesterly course, along
the said watercourse to a point near the center
of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18 in said township

thence Southwesterly along the natural course of the
stream bearing Easterly in its course to
a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Twp. as above,

where said stream joins
Crown Creek. It is designed, where practicable
to straighten said original watercourse; Also
it is desired that a branch ditch be laid
out and constructed in connection with the
above described ditch, described as follows to wit.

Commencing at a point near the Northwest
corner of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 T² R²⁴ W.
; thence southerly and southeasterly along
the natural course of the water or stream to
a point near the center of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section
18 T² R²³ W.
